- Eyepiece sets to stay with assigned telescope
- Eyepieces are <u>NEVER</u> to be placed in pockets Please return to case when not in use
- Respect the Dark <u>DIM</u>* **RED Lights only** from 8:00pm to 5:00am every night
- Curtains fully closed Front AND back
- Do NOT use Outside Lights Cover your outside light switches with tape
- Check your inside AND outside lights are OFF before you leave site each day











- ALL OzSky telescopes are for <u>SHARED</u> communal use No exclusive access
- Hints for sharing:
 - Join the queue if you want to use a specific telescope try to experience all the telescopes
 - Listen out for calls of "Who wants to look at NGC ####" especially from Andrew Murrell
 - Offer to share your observing list with others, or team up with others with similar observing lists
 - **Openly share telescopes between objects** if you are doing a long or challenging list
